

# SERMON Q's

**Our Christ-Centered Family**  
**February 7, 2021**  
**Colossians 3:15-17**

1. How would you tell your own family story? What about your story in the family of God? Who is featured? What brings you all together? What are you all about?

2. Think of a situation where you have disagreed with a brother or sister in Christ. How has the peace of Christ ruled as umpire? Or how would it have looked different if it did?

3. Do you feel “at home” in the gospel story? What would help that become the more natural story that impacts your daily decisions and priorities?

4. What ways beyond a Sunday service does the Word of God dwell richly in your life? Are there ways you’d like to see it more prominent in your own life or relationships in God’s family?

5. Does the good news of Jesus truly delight your heart - at times even producing joyful song? How is singing together an important part of teaching each other?

6. Thankfulness marks all three verses in this passage. Why do you think that is? Are you regularly full of gratitude for the gospel of Jesus? How would others see that?
