Work in Light of God
May 30, 2021
Proverbs 6:6-11

1. When someone asks you “what you do” or what “work” is for you, how do you answer? What other “jobs” do you spend significant time doing?
2. Do you think you tend to exaggerate or denigrate the value of work, compared to how the Bible views its value in God’s world?
3. Would you say you tend toward idolatrous workaholism or idolatrous laziness? Can you think of a way in which the other side of that coin a struggle for you, too?
4. When in your life have you felt the burden from the movie clip of working “to justify my whole existence” in a significant moment or event? How does that moment (or others like it) still impact you?
5. How does the work of Jesus define your value in ways beyond imagination? Tell someone else in your group in your own words how valuable they are in light of this.
6. What is one way someone could pray for you to be diligent in the work of restoration God has called you to alongside Him in his world?
