5. Why do you sometimes struggle to receive and listen to wise counsel? Why do you think this is such an important aspect of living in wisdom, in light of God (the fear of the Lord) in Proverbs?
6. How does the sacrificial friendship of Jesus empower you to be a good friend to other? In light of that, how could someone best pray for you to be or find a good friend?

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
