What Happens in Jericho...

Joshua 7-8

1. Can you think of a time in your life when your sin “found you out”? What does it feel like to be caught or exposed?
2. When have you seen the pattern of “I saw ... I coveted ... I took” in your life? What does hiding often look like for you after that?
3. Considering communal responsibility is uncomfortable for us. Where do you see this truth biblically? Where are examples of embracing it in our lives?
4. Pick racism, materialism, or pornography. Discuss the personal and corporate responsibility in the particular sin (both exist!). What do you learn from listening to others process this?
5. Is there particular sin God has brought to your mind that you need to have exposed? To whom and when will you confess it? If not, who knows you well enough to help you expose hidden sin?
6. How does it encourage you that God sets up an altar right in the midst of his people’s deserved curse? How does grace lead to repentance for you?
