Wise Warnings About Sex
June 27, 2021
Proverbs 5

1. Will asserted that everyone has been impacted by sexual brokenness because of the Fall. Is that true? Why do you think we often feel isolated in that brokenness and struggle to share about it with others? BONUS: How should the Gospel create a community where deep brokenness can be shared?

2. What are specific examples of ways our hearts ... our eyes ... and our pride lead us down the path of the “forbidden woman”?

3. Why do you think we can hear the clear warnings of Scripture and yet still so often end up on this dead-end path?

4. Read I Corinthians 6:15-20 together. How should our union with Christ impact the way we view and use our bodies?

5. Have you ever heard or given a speech like the one Matt Chandler heard about the rose? How do we sometimes neglect the Gospel story when we talk about sex, and why do you think that is? What’s often the primary takeaway for a young child or an unbeliever?

6. Describe the active awareness of the presence of God to the group in a way that both makes you long to run into his presence AND live in his ways. What do you find must be true about his character in any such description?
