4. How does GIVING fit into your family's budgeting practices? How do you feel about C.S. Lewis' urging to sacrificial giving, and how would such a "kingdom-first" approach change your habits?
5. Do you consider yourself a "cheerful giver"? What things most motivate you to give with joy?
6. Is the prayer of Agur (Proverbs 30:8-9) one you comfortably pray for yourself? Why or why not? How can we pray for our church corporately as we consider our stewardship of God's resources?
