The God of Our Inheritance
July 5, 2020
Joshua 10:16-21:45

1. Lists of people and places often don't excite us. But Joshua 21:43-45 was clearly meant to elicit praise and celebration of YHWH for all these "lists." How does seeing his faithfulness impact your heart?

2. Read Acts 13:17-31. As Paul narrates hundreds of years of history, who is the primary actor? How do you narrate your own story, and how might it sound different with the same primary actor?

3. Where in your life are you struggling to see God at work? How does God as Lord of history help your anxiety, uncertainty, or hopelessness?

4. Describe the "boundaries" where God has placed you here in Huntsville. What small or big places do you need to consider living for his glory?

5. Now describe the "boundaries" of your inheritance in Christ (Perhaps use Ephesians 1 to help). How does the character of God make you confident in these eternal realities?

6. What does it look or feel like for you to experience rest in God's presence? Where you don't experience it today, how could that change?
