**Colossians 1:1-8**

1. How are letters to churches in the New Testament applicable to us? Is it easy or hard for you to feel a part of the same story they are in?
2. Where in your life (especially a messy place!) do you need to hear God speak “grace and peace” to you?
3. Is it harder for you to feel the reality of being “in Christ” or “in Huntsville”? In what ways do you see your heavenly and earthly citizenship intersect?
4. Is it generally easier for you to find the bad or the good in something? Why is critique needed in general and in churches? How does the Gospel redirect us toward starting with thanks?
5. Where do you see the fruit of the Gospel (faith, love, hope) in our church in a way that makes you thankful to God?
6. How can we pray for your heart to be turned toward gratitude? What aspect of life makes that most challenging right now?
